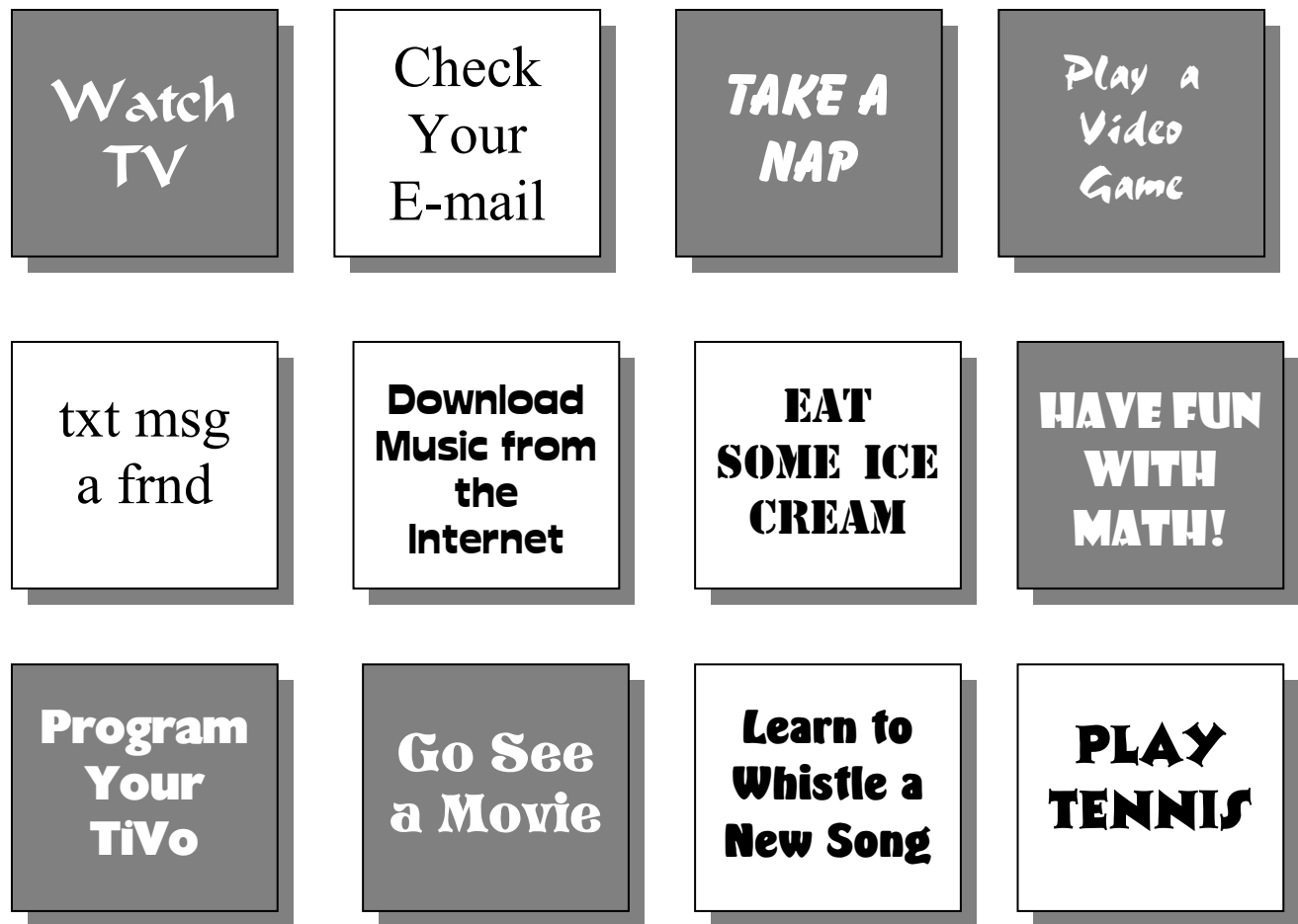


# What to Do, What to Do?
